15 16 17	before voters on November 4, 2014: <i>"The inalienable right to life of every human being at any stage of development must be recognized and protected."</i> The ambiguous phrasing of this amendment allows interpretations that could make it difficult for physicians to follow individuals' advance directives. Fear of		
17 18 19	lawsuits could negatively impact end-of-life care for people of all ages. It could also negatively impact organ donation, and dissuade physicians from practicing in North Dakota. Due to the open-ended wording
